





Overall Outcomes and Impact







Of 269 cases with determined outcomes in FY2023-24, 94 have a highly positive outcome* and 31 have a slight positive outcome. Casework outcomes are 58% overall positive.

*Outcomes are defined by adherence of advice. Positive for full adherence, slight positive for partial, neutral for unclear, and negative for no adherence.

Regional Casework Distribution




West Midlands and Yorkshire have the highest percentage of overall positive responses






HB&P does the most case work in Wales, the North West, and South West.

**The North East and Greater London have the fewest number of listed buildings


Additional Casework Distribution
