### TRUSTEES' REPORT for the Period Ended 31 December 2024

#### Introduction

The trustees present their annual report and accounts for the period ended 31 December 2024.

The CIO was registered on 23 September 2024 and the process of transferring the trade and assets of the original charity (Ancient Monuments Society) has begun but was not completed by the 31st December 2024. The trustees anticipate that the CIO will assume the activities of the charity in the following year.

#### Objectives and activities

The objectives of the CIO are:

The conservation for the benefit of the nation of places of historic interest, ancient monuments, historic buildings and examples of fine craftsmanship throughout Great Britain, to make representations in collaboration with other bodies or otherwise to the person or authorities concerned to secure the maintenance and conservation of ancient monuments and historic buildings; to assist, financially or otherwise, in the maintenance and conservation of objects of historic interest, and to give guidance and assistance, so far as in the power of the Society, to any person or organizations with these objects in view.

#### **Public benefit**

We confirm that the Trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit, in deciding on the activities of the CIO.

#### **Financial review**

The financial position is set out in the Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December 2024. These show net incoming resources from charitable activities for the year of £1,858, resulting in total unrestricted funds carried forward of £1,858.

#### Structure, Governance and Management

The CIO is incorporated and governed by its own constitution. The trustees have overall control and responsibility for policy and major decision making. The first meeting of the trustees of the CIO is scheduled to be held in January 2025.
